The New Albany Links Golf Course was sold prior to the end of the year by Links developer Joe Ciminello to "New Era Golf

Ohio." They own three other courses in Ohio: Royal American in Galena, Bent Tree in Sunbury, and Glenross in Delaware. Ray Finnerty is the General Manager of the group and works out of the Glenross facility. Currently the same people are employed at the golf course and continues to run as in the past.

A Columbus Dispatch article on January 30 described a free child care service offered by the First Presbyterian Church in Westerville on Thursday mornings during the school year. "Parents' Morning Out", from 9:30 am to noon, is open to the public and intended to provide parents with a break to go shopping or perform other errands. The program accommodates up to 15 children per week.

Our neighbor, **Linda Kretschmaier**, director of youth and family ministry at the church, helped start the program in 2010. She and two other women handle most of the child-watching duties with some help from several Otterbein University students that the church employs.

DCHA Board Meeting Summary

The DCHA Board met on January 16.

Urban Kraus reported on the Master Association meetings. He stated that the golf course had been sold to New Era Golf, Inc. which also owns three other courses. All fees will remain the same for now. We may be asked to maintain more areas as to mowing, mulching and fertilizing. Since the master association is expected to be transitioned to resident control this year, there may be an election of officers in the spring and we need a candidate for that ballot.

Tom Weiss gave the financial report which shows we have three residents in arrears on their payments. The budget for 2014 is in place.

Linda Kretschmaier reported on the club house. An outside faucet has been turned on twice so we will try to cover it with a lock box. A police report was made on this. The ceiling in the library has been painted and cracks in the ceilings of both bathrooms need to be addressed. We

need to ascertain if we do have a heating contract with M&L heating for three years because another company had to be called in December when M&L refused to respond when called. There have been no problems with our groups using the club house and the fireplace is operable but we are not sure how to start it and renters will not be allowed to use it.


